

Chippewa Valley Home Builders Association Community Service Projects Statement of Purpose, Goals & Disclaimer

- The Chippewa Valley Home Builders Association ongoing community service activities are an outlet for members to give their time, talents and resources to help their neighbors and their community. The CVHBA is not large enough to help every worthy person and group that seeks their assistance. The Board of Directors will determine each project on its individual merits, with initial screening by the CVHBA Public Relations Committee, selecting building projects they feel will make a positive impact in the lives of individuals, their families or community groups.
- Because CVHBA's member's time and resources are not unlimited, when choosing a project, the Public Relations Committee will define what is the primary need for help and the main objective to be achieved.
- When at all possible, the Public Relations Committee will do the project defined by primary need for help at little or no cost – relying on members to donate their time, talents and materials. When this is unrealistic, due to the size of the project, volunteer members availability or other project requests, they will do the project at as much of a discounted cost as possible.
- People and community groups requesting the assistance of the CVHBA are highly encouraged to organize fundraisers if their project will have a sizable cost. The Public Relations Committee will commit to working with the fundraiser group, donating as much time and materials as feasible and strategizing the best use of the fundraiser dollars.
- Sometimes when completing the work defined by the primary reason for CVHBA assistance, other requests arise that do not have anything to do with the initial request. For example, initially the CVHBA grants a request for a wheelchair access ramp and to widen doorways. Afterwards, the CVHBA is then asked to replace a worn countertop. As volunteer time and material resources are limited, the committee may not be in a position to fulfill these additional requests at little or no cost. At that point they will work with the individual or group, offering cost effective solutions or the services of CVHBA members who may be able to work within their budget parameters.



Annually, the Chippewa Valley Home Builders Association, a non-profit trade association of almost 350 building industry professionals representing Buffalo, Chippewa, Dunn, Eau Claire, and Pepin counties, participates in a volunteer capacity of giving back to the region.

To be considered, please submit a proposal that outlines the following points:

1. Contact Information: name, title, address, phone, fax, and email
2. Organization Mission Statement, if applicable
3. Project Name
4. Scope of the Project: include start and finish dates and project budget
5. Outline why this project meets community interest and our Association's support
6. Outline specific task(s) of volunteer activity you are requesting
7. Outline in detail your request (monetary donations, supplies, in-kind labor and/or equipment use)
8. List other community partners for the project
9. If applicable, attach the blueprints/drawings/photos for the project

All proposals must be sent to the CVHBA office. Proposals are reviewed quarterly.
